01.16.2022 **QUICKSILVER**

"Revered like rock stars within the early music scene" (New York Times), Quicksilver brings together today's top North American historically-informed performers. Described as "drop dead gorgeous with a wonderful interplay of timbres," (Early Music America) and praised as "irresistible" (Fanfare Magazine), Quicksilver vibrantly explores the rich chamber music repertoire from the late Renaissance to the High Baroque.

02.20.2022 **CUARTETO CASALS**

Founded in 1997 at the Escuela Reina Sofia in Madrid, **Cuarteto Casals** has been a repeat guest at the world's most prestigious concert halls including Carnegie Hall, Philharmonie Cologne, Cité de la Musique Paris, Schubertiade in Schwarzenberg, and Concertgebouw Amsterdam, among many others around the world. The members have recently added a highly praised recording of the Beethoven Quartets to their extensive discography on Harmonia Mundi. *Gramophone Magazine*, in reviewing the second volume of their Beethoven recordings, said "These interpretations don't just strip off the varnish; they tear off the gilded frame, X-ray the canvas, and light it in neon."

03.13.2022 **ESMÉ QUARTET**

In the short time since winning first prize and sweeping four of the special prizes at the 2018 Wigmore Hall International String Quartet Competition in London, the **Esmé Quartet** has made a sensational entrance into the string quartet world, performing at renowned concert halls and festivals around the world, and has been named the first Artists-in-Residence at the Lotte Concert Hall, in Seoul, South Korea. Based in Germany, the quartet was formed in 2016 at the Hochschule für Musik und Tanz Köln (Cologne), Germany, and is comprised of four Korean musicians who were already friends and shared common interests and passions in music, the arts, and life. The name of the quartet—Esmé—is borrowed from an old French word meaning "beloved."

04.03.2022 **QUATUOR ÉBÈNE**

"We need the inspiration of the audience," said cellist Raphaël Merlin of the esteemed **Quatuor Ébène**, which returns for its third performance with Coleman. These words were one of the central ideas of the "Beethoven Around the World" project, during which the quartet recorded Beethoven's 16 string quartets on six continents between May 2019 and January 2020. These recordings were also part of the quartet's 20th anniversary celebrations. Quatuor Ébène's albums have received numerous awards, including Gramophone, BBC Music Magazine, and the Midem Classic Award.

05.22.2022 MIRÓ QUARTET with MARTIN BEAVER and CLIVE GREENSMITH

The Miró Quartet will be joined by Martin Beaver, violin and Clive Greensmith, cello for a performance of Brahms's sextets. The quartet won the Barstow Award for Strings at the 1996 Coleman Competition, and is based in Austin, Texas, where it serves as quartet-in-residence at the Butler School of Music at the University of Texas, Austin. Messrs. Beaver (from 2002) and Greensmith (from 1999) were members of the Tokyo String Quartet until it disbanded in 2013. Both gentlemen are currently on the faculty of the Colburn School in Los Angeles and founding members of the Montrose Trio.
